Dear Fifth graders,

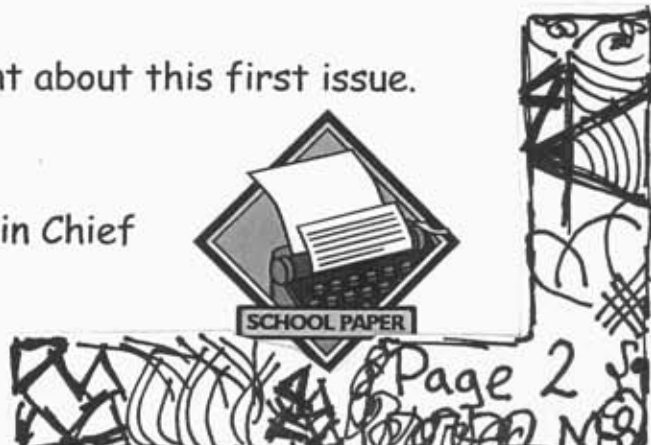

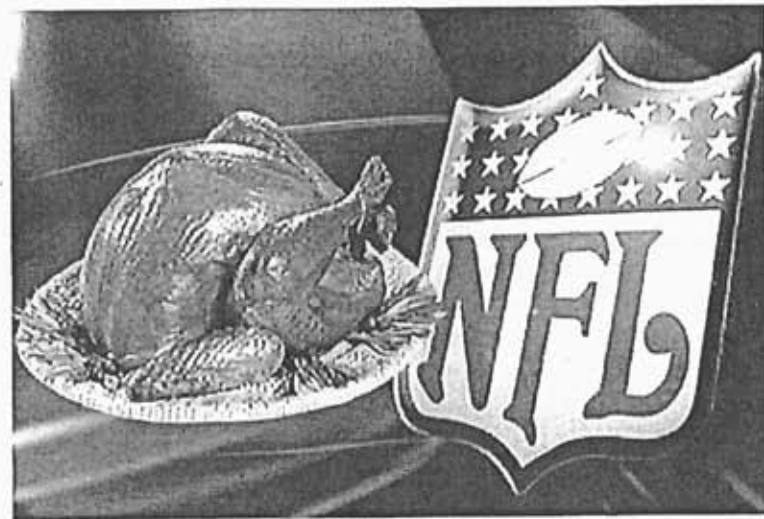

With more than 1/3 of the school population new this year - this is a great way to get to know people.

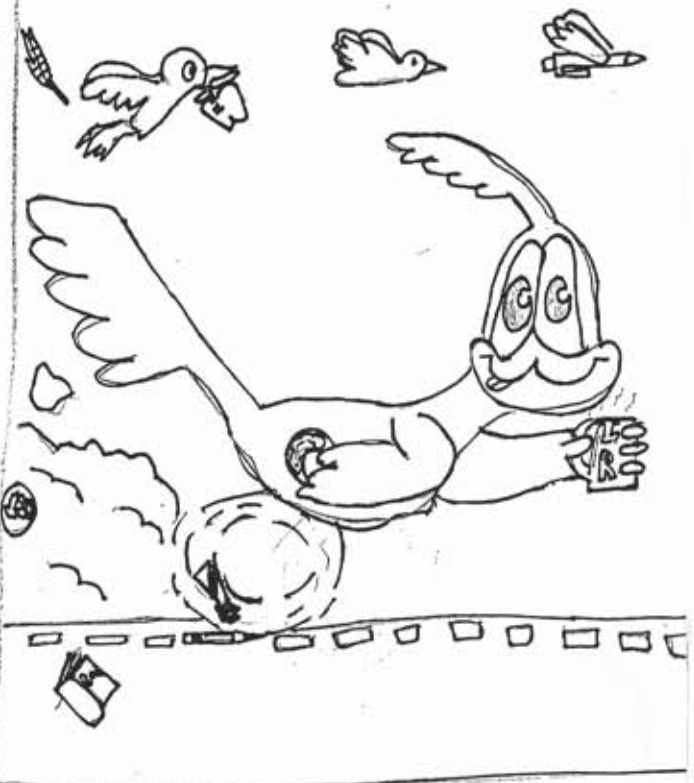

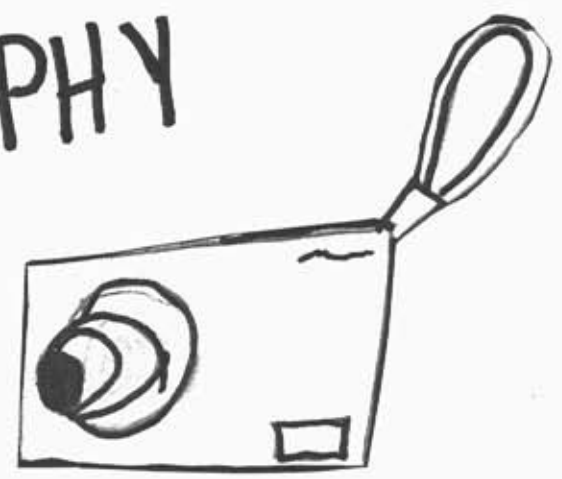
Is the Roadrunner getting a new look this year?

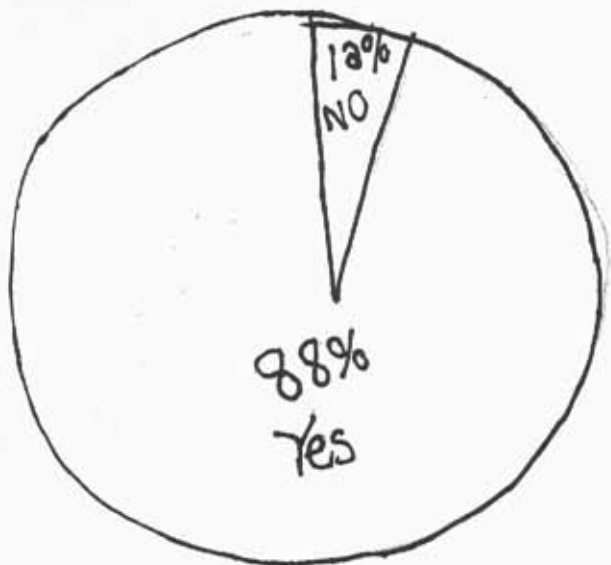
