What we do.

During Driver Training, your child will learn how to drive in many different situations. The lessons will include three different levels of driving with each lesson being built on the previous lessons' completion.

Lesson 1 will cover the basic understanding of the car, self defense driving techniques and an introduction to country driving in a rural setting. Upon completion, your child will be introduced to city driving and incorporate parallel parking in an urban setting. If successful, your child will experience the high volume of traffic on the highway as well as merging. The final three lessons will be devoted to perfecting the skills of the driver and building confidence in and around traffic.

Scheduling

Lessons will last one hour and be scheduled on a first come first served basis. Because academics are more important than driving, lessons will not be scheduled during school hours. Lessons will be scheduled from 3:00 pm—5:00 pm and on Saturdays. Students should meet the instructor in the front of the school unless otherwise arranged. Summer hours are also available.

What is the cost?

This is a behind the wheel training program that provides the minimum required six(6) hours for an insurance discount. Effective April 15, 2011 the cost for six(6) lessons is \$300. Please pay for all lessons on the first lesson. Additional hours can be obtained for \$50 per hour. A certificate will be issued upon completion.

Completion of a 30 hour classroom theory course is required to meet insurance requirements for premium discounts and license upgrades.
