Employing a continuous review process, the York Suburban School District (YSSD) will continue to communicate, implement, and assess the operations of all facilities. Furthermore, the District will review updates from the Pennsylvania Department of Health (PADoH) and reference recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to ensure any and all new PADoH mandates can be implemented accordingly. YSSD will remain flexible and responsive to meet the needs of the school and community.

The District will continue to address students' academic needs through curricular analysis and instructional planning. The social, emotional, and mental needs of students and staff

will be addressed through our continued work on trauma, social and emotional learning (SEL), and mental health. Curriculum development, additional social worker support, and professional learning on the aforementioned topics will be implemented.


